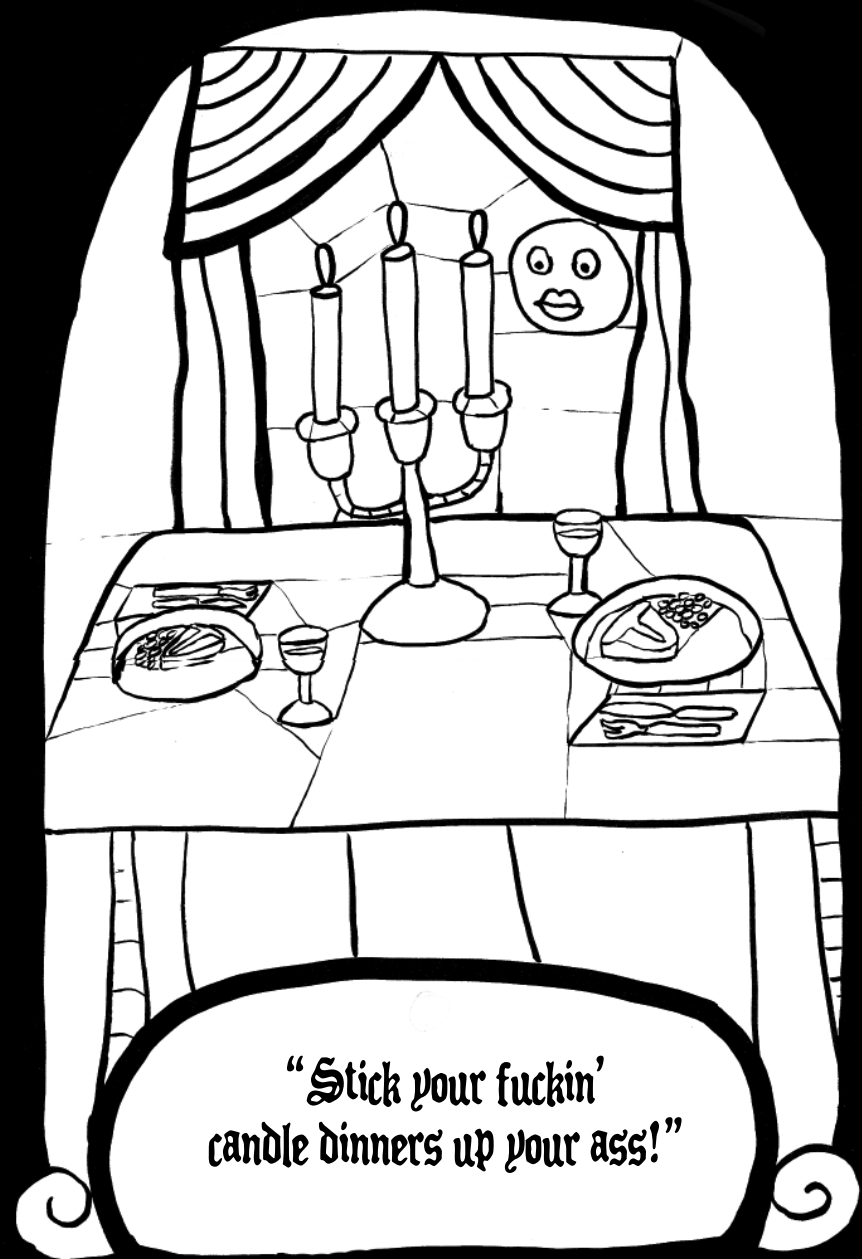

However, I was given to understand that everyone else in the house thinks he is good looking.



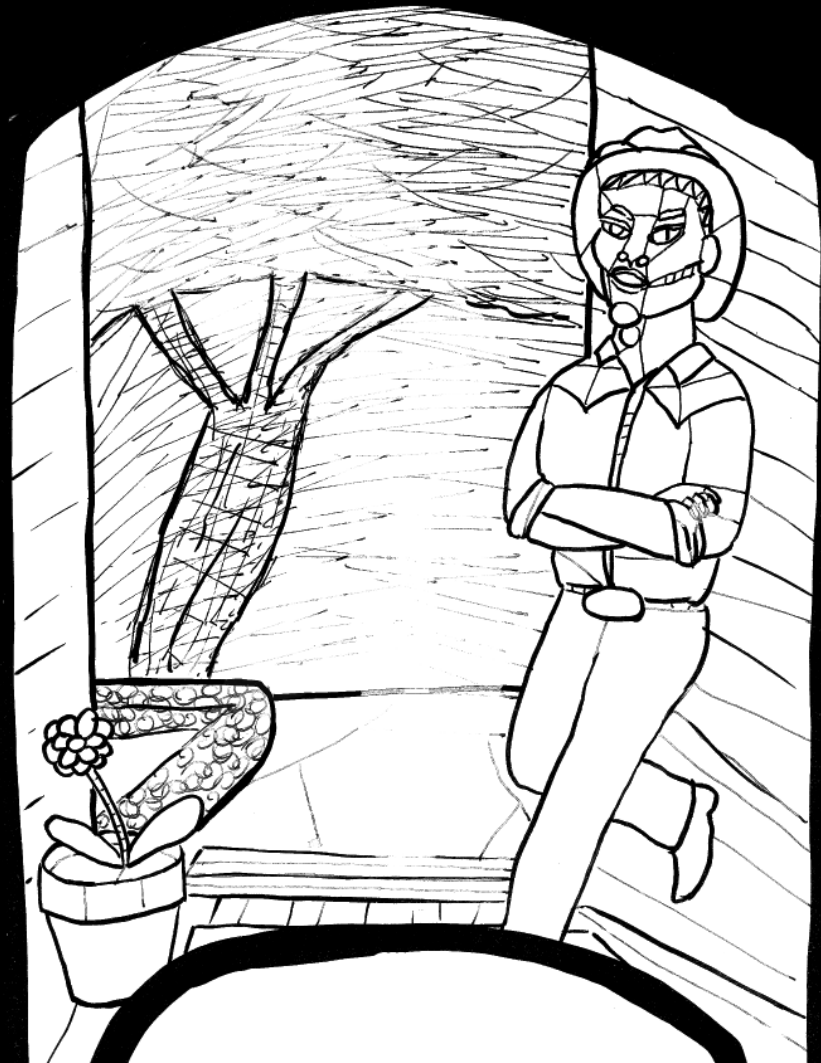
"Stick your fuckin' candle dinners up your ass!"

"NO!"



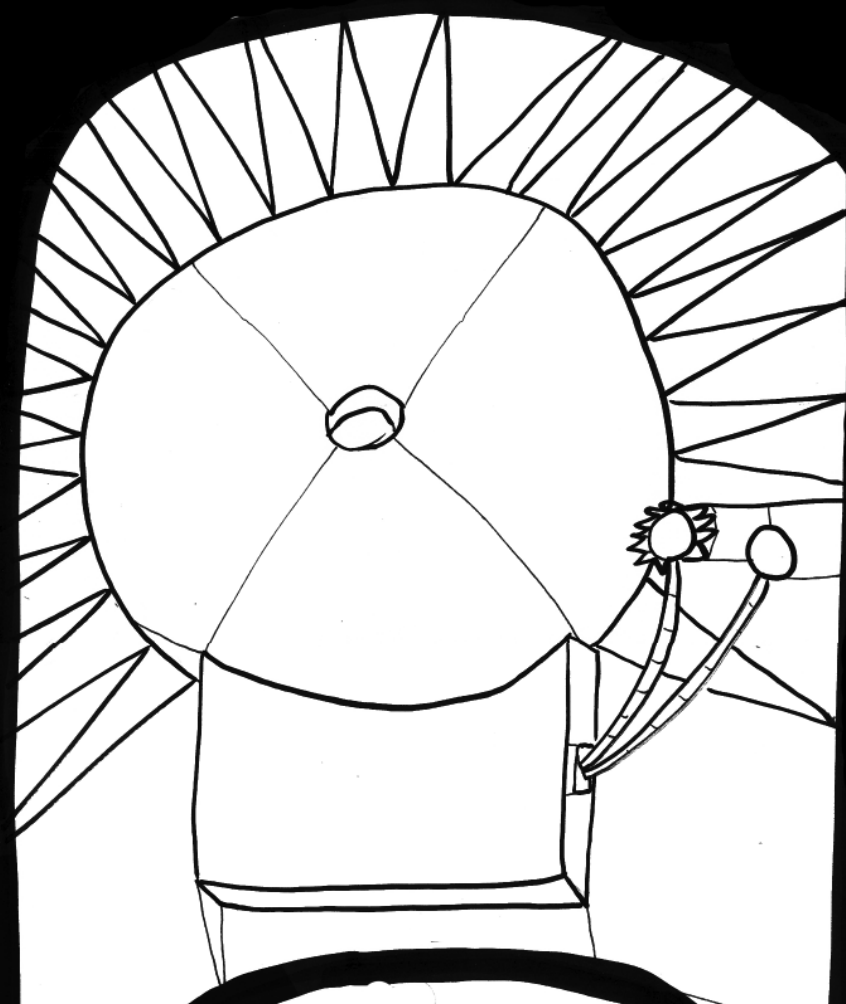
“Will you let me in?”

"I don't have to stay here when lots of people like me - I'm young and attractive - a hell of a lot better lookin than you are."



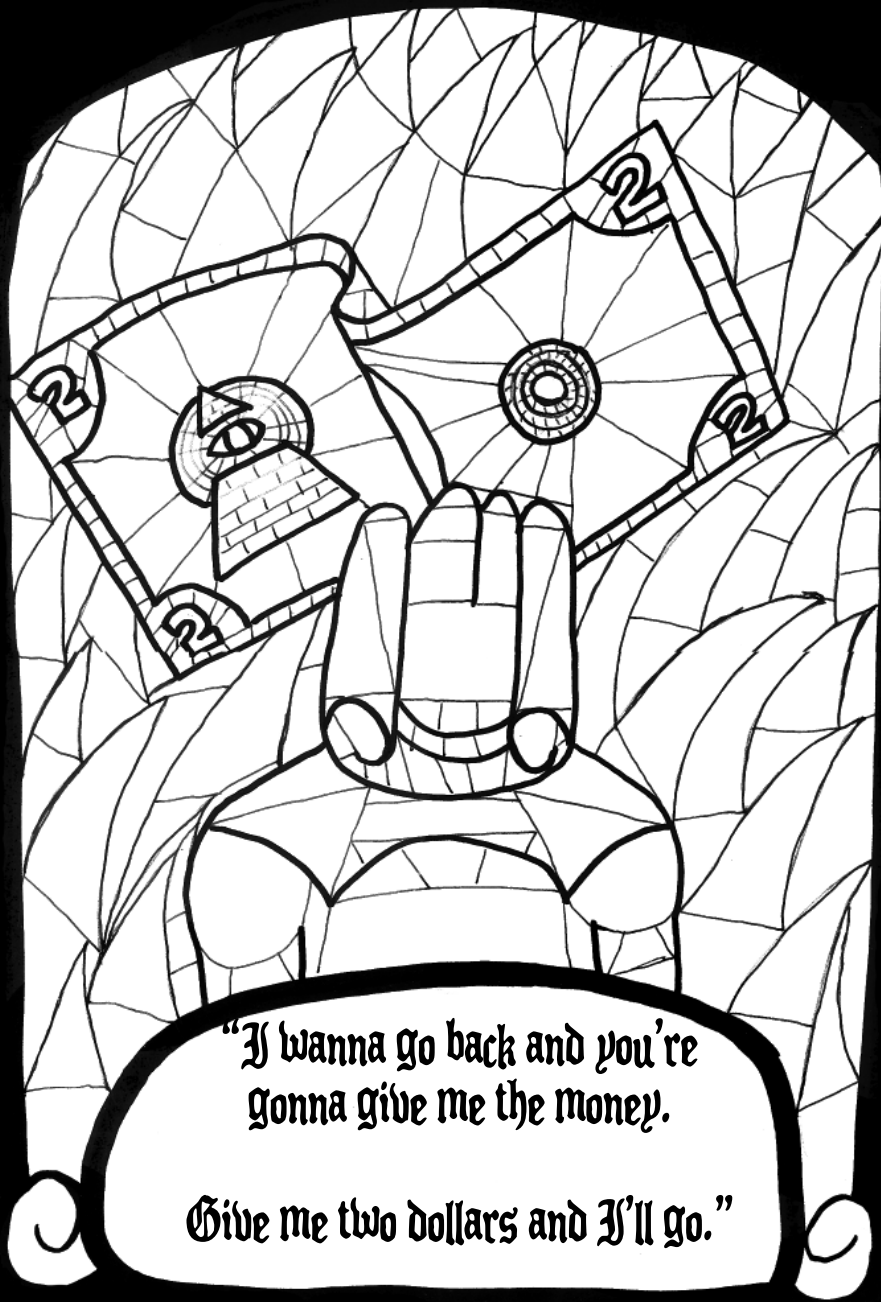
